

All visitors to Australia require a valid passport and visa to enter the country. **It is the participant's responsibility to obtain their visa.**

There are three visas that participants may be eligible to apply for online to visit Australia for tourism or business visitor activities. Eligibility for each of these three visas will depend on the participants' country of passport. Please check your eligibility using the links provided to determine the most appropriate visa option for you.

If you are eligible for all three visa options, any option would be fine and it is at your discretion which you choose to apply for. We note that there is no charge for the eVisitor and ETA visa applications (aside from an AUD20 service fee for use of the ETA website), so either of these may be the most practical.

1. eVisitor visa (subclass 651)

European Union (EU) passport holders, and some other European passport holders are eligible to apply online for an [eVisitor visa \(subclass 651\)](#) to travel to and enter Australia. The eVisitor visa allows for visits to Australia for business purposes for up to 3 months.

eVisitor-eligible passports are listed at: [Subclass 651 eVisitor \(homeaffairs.gov.au\)](#) and click on the Eligibility tab.

Applications for eVisitor visas are free.

2. Electronic Travel Authority (ETA) (subclass 601)

ETA eligible countries – Applying online

There is no visa application charge for ETA applications lodged online but a service fee of AUD20 is charged for use of the ETA website.

3. Visitor visa (Subclass 600) in the Business Visitor Stream

Passport holders who are not eligible to apply for an eVisitor visa or an ETA should apply for a [Visitor visa \(Subclass 600\) in the Business Visitor Stream](#).

Applicants who lodge their visa applications online will need to ensure that adequate supporting documents are attached to their online visa application.
